THEOLOGICAL FOUNDATION

DESCRIPTION

The name of the Lord possesses the power to transform lives, break strongholds, and defeat death.

VERSES

This song desires to give attention to life in Christ now, and pivots around the line in the verses, "miracles still happening." All of the allusions of the verses are not aimed at eternal life but on life transformation before death (sight, life, healing, freedom, etc.). The point being made is that, yes Jesus has, on the cross, at immense personal sacrifice, reconciled us for eternity to God, but eternity does not start when we die.

CHORUS

Of course, the life is offered by no other name than Jesus', and it is upon Him (and Him alone) that a person can call upon for salvation. It is His name that has the power to save (Acts 4:12), crushing the power of the grave (1 Cor. 15: 55-57) bring light into darkness (1 Pet. 2:9), with a hope that silences fear (1 Jn. 4:18) because He is the savior above all with the name above all other names (Phil. 2:9).

BRIDGE

The bridge revolves around the idea of strongholds. In addition to explaining what that means, the authors of the song give a summary of the song's message when they say,

"a stronghold is a Satanic lie, a generational mindset, or a human wounding that you have listened to long enough, believed strong enough, and owned deep enough that it has become part of your identity. It has fortified itself in you and dictated your thoughts, beliefs, actions and reactions. It is an unholy filter through which all thoughts pass." Identify what strongholds are in your life and believe that God can redeem you right now. God is always renewing and restoring us. Name the situation. They all have names, like cancer or an eating disorder. Compared to the name of Jesus, there's strength in singing as a body of believers and believing in His name as Lord over all."
